About the Organization:

The Omega CDC is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization established by the Omega Baptist Church in 1997. Our mission is to strengthen Northwest Dayton into a family supportive neighborhood through youth, family, and economic development. To accomplish our mission, we have successfully implemented several high-quality mentoring, educational, and life skills programs:

1. Mentoring (Boys, grades 5-8) at the Dayton Boys Preparatory School (third year)
2. Violence Prevention Education & ex-offender mentoring/case management through a partnership with Human Relations Council (ninth year)
3. Summer Literacy at Fairview Elementary (ages 6-12) (ninth year)
4. Afterschool Education Program at Fairview Elementary (Pre-K-6) (first year)
5. Work-Ready Life Skills Training (adults) at Fairview Elementary and United Rehabilitation Services (second year)

Responsibilities:

- Working with Omega CDC staff to discuss the images they require
- Working in different locations (Ex: Omega CDC, Fairview Elementary, Dayton Boys Prep School, and Omega Baptist Church)
- Taking pictures of individuals, families, and small groups
- Communicating with photographic subjects, putting them at ease, encouraging them and directing them
- Reviewing photographs to select the best
